December 11, 2018

Judge Carr will hear UCDs beginning at 9:30 a.m.

December 12, 2018

Judge Eaves will hear UCDs beginning at 10:30 a.m.

December 19, 2018

Criminal Judge 1 and a Senior Judge will hear UCDs beginning at 1:30 p.m.

December 27, 2018

Judge Eaves and Judge Bowen will hear UCDs beginning at 1:30 p.m.
Judge Dugan will be available to assist as needed.

December 28, 2018

Judge Dugan will hear UCDs beginning at 9:30 a.m.

December 31, 2018

All of the sitting judges and Senior Judge Plitt will be available all day to hear UCDs

If you have a UCD that is currently scheduled for a hearing in 2019 and you would like to have it resolved on one of the above-designated 2018 dates, please contact the Assignment Office at 410-638-3247 to have the case scheduled. Or if your case has not yet been scheduled, you also may contact the Assignment Office to schedule the case, as long as it is ripe for a hearing.

Attorneys must e-file proposed Judgments of Absolute Divorce in advance or bring one to the hearing. The Court will prepare Judgments of Absolute Divorce for cases where both parties are self-represented. Vital Statistics forms will be available in the courtrooms.

If your case cannot be resolved as a UCD, it will be rescheduled on the Court's trial calendar.
